THE SCIENTIFIC BENEFITS OF ARTS EDUCATION

Participation in theater arts has been shown to enhance students' academic performance, with improvements in reading comprehension, verbal skills, and overall academic achievement. This is attributed to the discipline, memorization, and comprehension skills that theater activities demand. Additionally, involvement in theater arts fosters critical thinking and creativity, encouraging students to approach problems and situations from multiple perspectives and think outside the box. Beyond academics, theater arts participation positively affects students' social and emotional development. It helps build self-confidence and self-esteem as students perform in front of audiences and receive feedback on their work. Theater also promotes teamwork and collaboration, as students must work closely with their peers to produce successful performances. This collaborative environment helps students develop strong communication skills and a sense of empathy, as they must understand and convey different characters' emotions and motivations.

THE CHALLENGE

We are extremely fortunate and grateful for the opportunity to stage our productions through Cobb County Schools facilities rentals. However, we're no strangers to the challenges associated with scheduling conflicts, usage restrictions, disparate layouts, maintenance difficulties, and variable lighting and sound setups from facility to facility—not to mention costly storage and transport of sets and costumes. It's not uncommon for our performances to have as little as one hour after final curtain to clear the audience, strike the set, and reset and clean the theater. Even with the help of a small army of volunteers, it can be tough.

We're also very aware of the benefit to our students and families in the ability to plan ahead based on a predictable expectation of our programs' location.

We anticipate that these issues and more will be resolved by our dedicated arts center.

THE ULTIMATE GOAL: OUR OWN SCHOOL OF THE ARTS

In addition to funding this production, contributions keep our organization on track to continue to benefit students to the greatest possible extent.
